To access the EduTourism4Africa platform, users must first register for an account.


Follow these steps:

 1. Username
 2. Password (minimum 8 characters, including uppercase, lowercase, digits, and special characters)
 3. Email address (valid and accessible)
 4. Personal information (name, country, city)
- Submit the form. A confirmation email will be sent with a verification link.

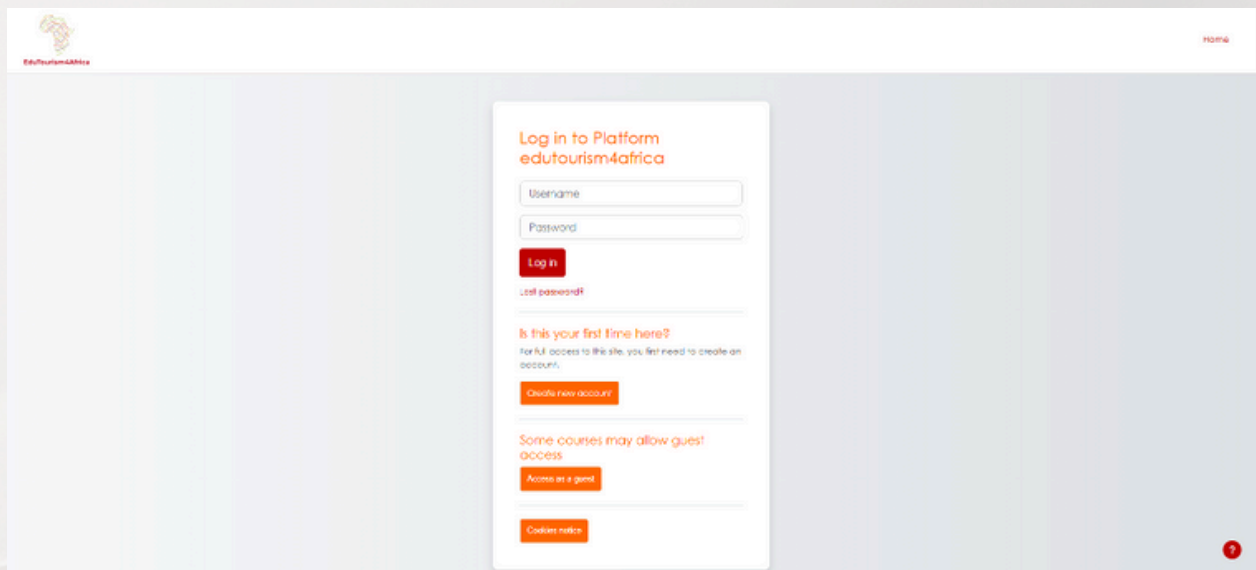
SIGN-UP PROCEDURE
